



GYMNASTICS TRAINING



COMMITMENT

Competitive cheerleading is an absolute TEAM sport. Whenever a single cheerleader misses practice, an entire stunt group (3-4 girls) cannot train. Cheerleaders are only allowed two unexcused absences for the entire season. If three practices are missed without an excuse, we will place the cheerleader on a new team that trains and performs but doesn't compete with a team.

Unexcused Absences

TES Athletics strives to create self-reliant leaders! This is why we teach our girls early what unexcused absences are in the real world. Examples of unexcused absences are:

-Poor time management: Oversleeping
-Poor planning: Booking hair appointments or parties at the same time as practice.

-Poor planning: Zero transportation to/from practice.

Excused Absences

TES Athletics understands that life happens; this is why excused absences are most of the time out of our control. Examples of excused absences are:

-Cheerleader is ill.

-Cheerleader's transportation vehicle is having issues.
-Close relation death.

COMPETITION PREP



Competition season is such an exciting and busy time of the year for cheerleaders. We have combined all cheer gear/competition fee payments into three fundraisers at the beginning of the season. Now cheer families has additional time to properly prepare for competition season without worrying about any additional fees/ fundraisers this year.

Traveling

TES Athletics is determined to have our competition trips to fit into every cheer family's lifestyle. Taking a road trip, flying an airplane or carpool with other families to attend your cheerleader's events is completely your choice! Transporting and looking after your cheerleader is the parent's responsibility for ever competitions. Coach Kamaria will only chaperon team trips when FULL PAID BIDS are won as an rewards for their accomplishments!

Hotels

Some of our competition event's host provides links to book your individual rooms. These hotel referrals are not mandatory for anyone to stay at but are just the event's host most convenient hotel referral. Feel free to book any hotels/motels near our competitions or even stay with a nearby relative.

Competition schedules are not released until the Monday prior to the event. This is why we require all athletes to arrive to their hotel the Friday before our competition days for out of town competitions.

D2 BIDS (Red Tails Only)

TES Athletics' goal is to have all of our athletes to become a D1/D2 team with the program. This season the Red Tails qualified to compete at D2 competitions! The most prestigious competition for all D2 cheer teams is to qualify for the D2 Summit and The One Championship. Our girls only opportunity to receive this BID is from the NCA and Kalahari's competition.

A D2 Bid cover a 4-5 night package at the event's Value Hotel with zero competition fee! The Red Tails will have a memorable trip by traveling as a team with Coach Kamaria to these elite competitions (parents are welcome to book flights and hotels as well elite competition (parents are welcome to book flights and hotels as well).l).

The last step for these possible trip is to come up with a single fundraiser to cover the girl's flights and spending money. This fundraiser will be orchestrated by the Red Tails' parents committee with Coach Kamaria's assistance.


